

Join us for the Historical Society of Frederick County's

Bus Trip to Fallingwater & Kentuck Knob

Friday, April 27, 2012 • 7:00 a.m.—5:30 p.m.

Join us as we travel to Western Pennsylvania to visit two homes designed by the nation's most famous architect, **Frank Lloyd Wright**. In his lifetime, Wright designed 1,000 buildings and completed 500 based on his philosophy of organic architecture, structures in harmony with humanity and the environment. The homes on our trip are two his finest examples.

Our first stop will be to **Kentuck Knob**, located on the westernmost ridge of Pennsylvania's Allegheny Mountains and recessed into a mountain peak. The home offers sweeping vistas of the Youghiogheny River gorge and surrounding countryside. Kentuck Knob was built with tidewater red cypress, glass, and native sandstone, and topped with a copper roof. Anchored by a hexagonal stone core, the crescent-shaped house surrounds an interior courtyard. It was one of the last homes completed by Wright, who designed it for I.N. and Bernadine Hagan in 1953 while working on the Guggenheim Museum, and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

After enjoying lunch on our way to nearby Mill Run, we will be provided tours of **Fallingwater**. Constructed for the Kaufman family between 1935 and 1939, the home is one of Frank Lloyd Wright's greatest masterpieces. The National Historic Landmark is listed on *Smithsonian* magazine's Life List of places to "visit before you die," and was voted the best all-time work of American architecture by the American Institute of Architects. Instead of providing his clients with a breathtaking view of the falls, Wright created a home situated over the falls themselves. Fallingwater, which doesn't appear to stand on solid ground, instantly captured the public's attention and was featured on the cover of *Time* magazine in 1938.

The bus trip fee includes deluxe motor coach transportation, guided tours of both sites, boxed lunch, and snacks on the bus. **Registration is limited and accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.** Refunds cannot be issued after the deadline, and no exchanges will be made for those who register but do not attend. 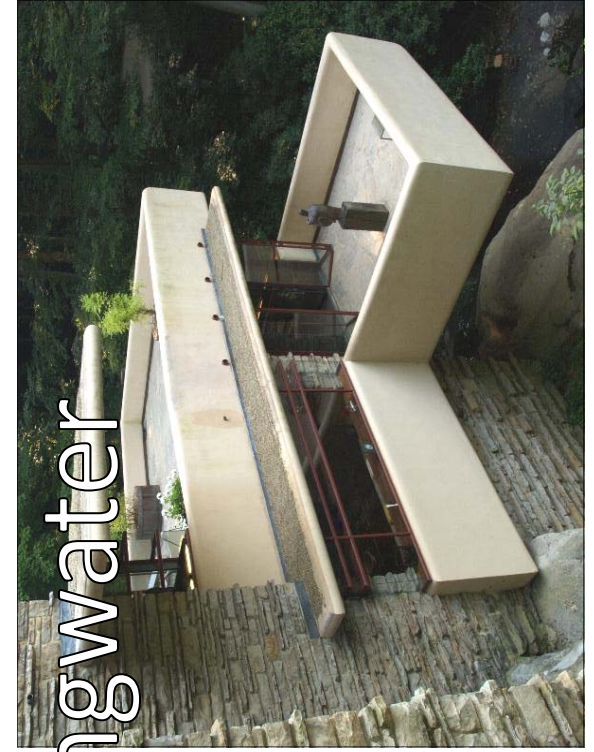
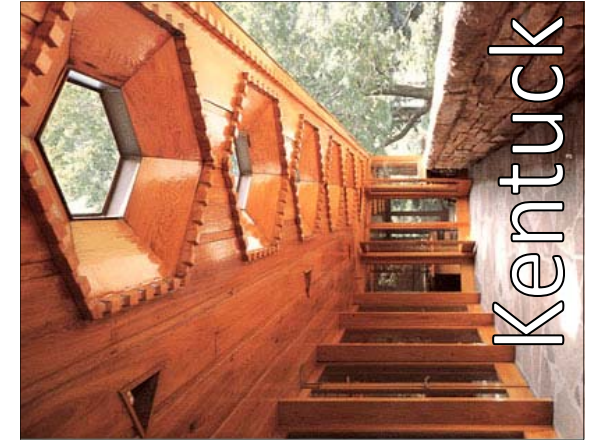
